# OUTLOOK: AEROSPACE Tinker Air Force Base is the largest single-site employer in the State of Oklahoma. That has led the government and private companies to continue investing here and adding employees, absorbing some job losses in oil and gas. Aerospace companies continue to enter the market to tap into the highly trained workforce and government contracts.
